2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MAXINE S. POSTAL UNITED STATES POST OF-**
2 **FICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 695 Marconi Boulevard in
5 Copiague, New York, shall be known and designated as
6 the “Maxine S. Postal United States Post Office Build-
7 ing”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the Maxine S. Postal
12 United States Post Office Building.
