## A BILL

To extend for eighteen months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11, United States Code, is reenacted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Family Farmer Bank-  
5 ruptcy Relief Act of 2004”.

1 **SEC. 2. EIGHTEEN-MONTH EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR**  
2 **WHICH CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 11, UNITED**  
3 **STATES CODE, IS REENACTED.**

4 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 149 of title I of division  
5 C of Public Law 105–277 (11 U.S.C. 1201 note) is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking “January 1, 2004” each place  
8 that term appears and inserting “July 1, 2005”;  
9 and

10 (2) in subsection (a)—

11 (A) by striking “June 30, 2003” and in-  
12 serting “December 31, 2003”; and

13 (B) by striking “July 1, 2003” and insert-  
14 ing “January 1, 2004”.

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
16 subsection (a) are deemed to have taken effect on January  
17 1, 2004.
