A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area in the State of California, to restore and extend the term of the advisory commission for the recreation area, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Rancho Corral de Tier-
3 ra Golden Gate National Recreation Area Boundary Ad-
4 justment Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. GOLDEN GATE NATIONAL RECREATION AREA, CALI-
6 FORNIA.**

7 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.—Section 2(a) of Pub-
8 lic Law 92–589 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–1(a)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “The recreation area shall com-
10 prise” and inserting the following:

11 “(1) INITIAL LANDS.—The recreation area shall
12 comprise”; and

13 (2) by striking “The following additional lands
14 are also” and all that follows through the period at
15 the end of the subsection and inserting the following
16 new paragraphs:

17 “(2) ADDITIONAL LANDS.—In addition to the
18 lands described in paragraph (1), the recreation area
19 shall include the following:

20 “(A) The parcels numbered by the Asses-
21 sor of Marin County, California, 119–040–04,
22 119–040–05, 119–040–18, 166–202–03, 166–
23 010–06, 166–010–07, 166–010–24, 166–010–
24 25, 119–240–19, 166–010–10, 166–010–22,
25 119–240–03, 119–240–51, 119–240–52, 119–

1 240–54, 166–010–12, 166–010–13, and 119–
2 235–10.

3 “(B) Lands and waters in San Mateo
4 County generally depicted on the map entitled
5 ‘Sweeney Ridge Addition, Golden Gate National
6 Recreation Area’, numbered NRA GG–80,000–
7 A, and dated May 1980.

8 “(C) Lands acquired under the Golden
9 Gate National Recreation Area Addition Act of
10 1992 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–1 note; Public Law
11 102–299).

12 “(D) Lands generally depicted on the map
13 entitled ‘Additions to Golden Gate National
14 Recreation Area’, numbered NPS–80–076, and
15 dated July 2000/PWR–PLRPC.

16 “(E) Lands generally depicted on the map
17 entitled ‘Rancho Corral de Tierra Additions to
18 the Golden Gate National Recreation Area’,
19 numbered NPS–80–079C and dated January
20 2003, except that lands and interests in lands
21 constituting the Devil’s Slide Tunnel alternative
22 are not included in the recreation area. The
23 Secretary shall modify the boundary map re-
24 ferred to in this subparagraph to reflect the ex-
25 clusion of such lands and interests in lands.

1 “(3) ACQUISITION LIMITATION.—The Secretary
2 may acquire land described in paragraph (2)(E) only
3 from a willing seller.”.

4 (b) EXTENSION OF TERM OF ADVISORY COMMIS-
5 SION.—Effective as of October 26, 2002, section 5(g) of
6 Public Law 92–589 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–4(g)) is amended
7 by striking “cease to exist thirty years after the enactment
8 of this Act” and inserting “terminate at the end of the
9 10-year period beginning on the date of the enactment of
10 the Rancho Corral de Tierra Golden Gate National Recre-
11 ation Area Boundary Adjustment Act”.
