Mr. FRIST submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 on any day from Thursday, June 24, 2004, through Mon-
4 day, June 28, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its majority leader or his des-
6 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tues-
7 day, July 6, 2004, or at such other time on that day as
8 may be specified by its majority leader or his designee in
9 the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any
10 reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-

1 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the House ad-
2 journals on the legislative day of Thursday, June 24, 2004,
3 or Friday, June 25, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant
4 to this concurrent resolution by its majority leader or his
5 designee, it stand adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday,
6 July 6, 2004, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
7 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
8 first.

9 SEC. 2. The majority leader of the Senate and the
10 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
11 jointly after consultation with the minority leader of the
12 Senate and the minority leader of the House, shall notify
13 the Members of the Senate and the House, respectively,
14 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
15 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
16 warrant it.
