Mr. LOTT (for himself and Mr. DODD) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Establishing the Joint Congressional Committee on
Inaugural Ceremonies.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF JOINT COMMITTEE.**

4 There is established a Joint Congressional Committee
5 on Inaugural Ceremonies (in this resolution referred to as
6 the “joint committee”), consisting of 3 Senators and 3
7 Members of the House of Representatives appointed by
8 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House
9 of Representatives, respectively. The joint committee is
10 authorized to make the necessary arrangements for the

1 inauguration of the President-elect and the Vice Presi-
2 dent-elect of the United States.

3 **SEC. 2. SUPPORT OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE.**

4 The joint committee—

5 (1) is authorized to utilize appropriate equip-
6 ment and the services of appropriate personnel of
7 departments and agencies of the Federal Govern-
8 ment, under arrangements between the joint com-
9 mittee and the heads of the departments and agen-
10 cies, in connection with the inaugural proceedings
11 and ceremonies; and

12 (2) may accept gifts and donations of goods
13 and services to carry out its responsibilities.
