## RESOLUTION

Designating February 11, 2003, as “National Inventors’  
Day”.

Whereas the American people and the world have benefited  
from the creations and discoveries of America’s inventors;  
and

Whereas the patents that protect those creations and discov-  
eries spur technological progress, improve the quality of  
life, stimulate the economy, and create jobs for Ameri-  
cans: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the Senate—

1           (1) honors the important role played by inven-  
2           tors in promoting progress in the useful arts;

3           (2) recognizes the invaluable contribution of in-  
4           ventors to the welfare of the people of the United  
5           States;

6           (3) designates February 11, 2003, as “National  
7           Inventors’ Day”; and

8           (4) requests the President to issue a proclama-  
9           tion calling upon the people of the United States to  
10          celebrate such day with appropriate ceremonies and  
11          activities.
