A BILL

To designate the annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman Federal Building and United States Courthouse located at 333 Constitution Avenue Northwest in the District of Columbia as the “William B. Bryant Annex”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman Federal
5 Building and United States Courthouse located at 333
6 Constitution Avenue Northwest in the District of Colum-
7 bia shall be known and designated as the “William B. Bry-
8 ant Annex”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the annex
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “William B. Bryant Annex”.

6 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 This Act shall become effective on the day on which
8 William B. Bryant, a senior judge for the United States
9 District Court for the District of Columbia, relinquishes
10 or otherwise ceases to hold a position as a judge under
11 Article III of the Constitution.
