## A BILL

3       **SECTION 1. DOCUMENTATION OF VESSEL MONTAGUE.**

4       Notwithstanding section 27 of the Merchant Marine  
5       Act, 1920 (46 App. U.S.C. 883), section 8 of the Act of  
6       June 19, 1886 (46 App. U.S.C. 289), sections 12106 and  
7       12108 of title 46, United States Code, the Secretary of

1 the department in which the Coast Guard is operating  
2 may issue a certificate of documentation with appropriate  
3 endorsement for employment in the fisheries and coastwise  
4 trade for the vessel MONTAGUE (United States official  
5 number 1158063).
