A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to punish the placing of sexually explicit photographs on the Internet without the permission of the persons photographed.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Personal Pictures Pro-
5 tection Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. SEXUALLY EXPLICIT PHOTOGRAPHS ON THE INTER-**
2 **NET.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Part I of title 18, United States
4 Code, is amended by inserting after chapter 79 the fol-
5 lowing:

6 **“CHAPTER 80—PERSONAL PRIVACY**

“Sec.

“1631. Sexually explicit photographs on the Internet.

7 **“§ 1631. Sexually explicit photographs on the Internet**

8 “Whoever, with the intent to embarrass or cause
9 emotional distress to another person places on a computer
10 photographs of the sexually explicit conduct (as defined
11 in section 2256) of that person so that such photographs
12 are accessible on the Internet, without the permission of
13 that other person, shall be fined under this title or impris-
14 oned not more than 2 years, or both.”.

15 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
16 for part I of title 18, United States Code, is amended by
17 inserting after the item relating to chapter 79 the fol-
18 lowing new item:

“80. Personal privacy.”.
