5 Paragraph (6) of subsection (a) of section 444 of the
6 General Education Provisions Act (20 U.S.C. 1232g; also
7 known as the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
8 of 1974) is amended by inserting “(other than a person
9 educated at a home school, whether or not a home school

1 is treated as a home school or a private school under State
2 law)” after “does not include a person”.
