## A BILL

To provide grants for prosecutions of cases cleared through  
use of DNA backlog clearance funds.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Grants for DNA Back-  
5       log Prosecutions Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ASSISTANCE FOR PROSECUTIONS OF CASES**  
2 **CLEARED THROUGH USE OF DNA BACKLOG**  
3 **CLEARANCE FUNDS.**

4 The Justice for All Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–  
5 405) is amended by adding after section 206 the following  
6 new section:

7 **“SEC. 207. ASSISTANCE FOR PROSECUTIONS OF CASES**  
8 **CLEARED THROUGH USE OF DNA BACKLOG**  
9 **CLEARANCE FUNDS.**

10 “(a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Attorney General shall  
11 make grants to train and employ personnel to help pros-  
12 ecute cases cleared through use of funds provided for  
13 DNA backlog elimination.

14 “(b) **AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**—There  
15 are authorized to be appropriated \$100,000,000 for each  
16 of fiscal years 2006 through 2010 to carry out this sec-  
17 tion.”.
