3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reverse Mortgages to
5 Help America’s Seniors Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF CAP ON NUMBER OF MORTGAGES**
2 **INSURED.**

4 1715z-20) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (g), by striking the first sen-
6 tence; and

7 (2) in subsection (i)(1)(C), by striking “limita-
8 tions” and inserting “limitation”.
