A BILL

To prohibit the issuance of any Federal or State permit or lease for new oil and gas slant, directional, or offshore drilling in or under one or more of the Great Lakes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GREAT LAKES OIL AND GAS DRILLING BAN.**

4 No Federal or State permit or lease shall be issued
5 for new oil and gas slant, directional, or offshore drilling
6 in or under one or more of the Great Lakes.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

2 As used in this Act, the term “Great Lakes” has the
3 same meaning as provided by section 118(a)(3) of the
4 Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
5 1268(a)(3)).
