Mr. EDWARDS (for himself and Mr. OBEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

Making emergency supplemental appropriations for the Department of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year 2005 for veterans medical services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-
5 cal year 2005:

6 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

7 VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION

8 MEDICAL SERVICES

9 For an additional amount for “Medical Services”,
10 \$1,500,000,000, to remain available until September 30,

1 2006: *Provided*, That the amount provided under this
2 heading is designated as an emergency requirement pursu-
3 ant to section 402 of H. Con. Res. 95 (109th Congress),
4 the concurrent resolution on the budget for the fiscal year
5 2006: *Provided further*, That amounts made available
6 under this heading may be transferred to other accounts
7 of the Department of Veterans Affairs to the extent nec-
8 essary to reimburse those accounts for prior transfers to
9 “Medical Services” after notice of the amount and purpose
10 of the transfer is provided to the Committees on Appro-
11 priations of the Senate and House of Representatives and
12 a period of 30 days has elapsed: *Provided further*, That
13 the transfer authority in this paragraph is in addition to
14 any other transfer authority available to the Department
15 of Veterans Affairs.
