A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to construct
a fence along the southern border of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Border Security Im-
5 provement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONSTRUCTION OF FENCE ON SOUTHERN BORDER.**

2 Section 102 of the Illegal Immigration Reform and
3 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1103
4 note) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “Attorney General” each place
6 such term appears and inserting “Secretary of
7 Homeland Security”;

8 (2) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
9 subsections (d) and (e), respectively;

10 (3) in subsection (b), by striking “subsection
11 (d),” and inserting “subsection (e),”; and

12 (4) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
13 lowing:

14 “(c) CONSTRUCTION OF FENCE ON SOUTHERN BOR-
15 DER.—

16 “(1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out subsection
17 (a), the Secretary of Homeland Security shall pro-
18 vide for the construction of a fence along the entire
19 southern border of the United States.

20 “(2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
21 There are authorized to be appropriated
22 \$2,000,000,000 to carry out paragraph (1).”.
