## AN ACT

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 3000 Homewood Avenue in Baltimore, Maryland, as the “State Senator Verda Welcome and Dr. Henry Welcome Post Office Building”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. STATE SENATOR VERDA WELCOME AND DR.**  
2 **HENRY WELCOME POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
4 Postal Service located at 3000 Homewood Avenue in Bal-  
5 timore, Maryland, shall be known and designated as the  
6 “State Senator Verda Welcome and Dr. Henry Welcome  
7 Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “State Senator Verda  
12 Welcome and Dr. Henry Welcome Post Office Building”.
