A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to seek the establishment of a conference where Iranian nationals who oppose the policies of the Government of Iran can discuss the future of the Government of Iran.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONFERENCE FOR DISCUSSIONS BY IRANIAN**
4 **NATIONALS OPPOSING POLICIES OF THE**
5 **GOVERNMENT OF IRAN.**

6 (a) ACTIONS BY SECRETARY OF STATE.—The Sec-
7 retary of State shall take the necessary steps to encourage
8 and support the establishment of a conference or other

1 forum at which Iranian nationals, or representatives there-
2 of, who oppose the policies of the current Government of
3 Iran can meet and discuss reforms of that Government
4 and how those reforms may be carried out.

5 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—The Secretary of State
6 shall, not later than 6 months after the date of the enact-
7 ment of this Act, report to the Congress—

8 (1) the steps taken under subsection (a); and

9 (2) which groups of Iranian nationals have ex-
10 pressed interest in convening a conference or other
11 forum described in subsection (a).

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
