## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to provide for an on-going cost-of-living increase in the Medicaid disproportionate share hospital (DSH) allotments for States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disproportionate  
5 Share Hospital Assistance Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. ANNUAL CPI INCREASE IN MEDICAID DSH ALLOT-**  
2 **MENTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1923(f)(3) of the Social  
4 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396r-4(f)(3)) is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (C)—

6 (A) by amending the heading to read as  
7 follows: “STATE DSH ALLOTMENTS FOR FISCAL  
8 YEAR 2004 AND THEREAFTER”;

9 (B) by striking “and” at the end of clause  
10 (i);

11 (C) by amending clause (ii) to read as fol-  
12 lows:

13 “(ii) for fiscal year 2005 and for fiscal  
14 year 2006 is equal to the DSH allotment  
15 for the State for fiscal year 2004 under  
16 this paragraph, notwithstanding subpara-  
17 graph (B); and”;

18 (D) by adding at the end the following new  
19 clause:

20 “(iii) for each succeeding fiscal year is  
21 equal to the DSH allotment for the State  
22 for the previous fiscal year increased by  
23 the percentage change in the consumer  
24 price index for all urban consumers (all  
25 items; U.S. city average) for the previous  
26 fiscal year.”; and

1           (2) by striking subparagraph (D).

2           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
3 subsection (a) shall apply to allotments for fiscal years be-  
4 ginning with fiscal year 2007.
