A BILL

To redesignate Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historic Park in the State of Ohio as “Wright Brothers-Dunbar National Historic Park,” and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wright Brothers-Dun-
5 bar National Historic Park Designation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REDESIGNATION OF DAYTON AVIATION HERITAGE**

7 **NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

8 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The Act titled “An Act to es-
9 tablish the Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historic

1 Park in the State of Ohio, and for other purposes”, ap-
2 proved October 16, 1992 (106 Stat. 2141), is amended—

3 (1) by striking “Dayton Aviation Heritage Na-
4 tional Historical Park” each place it appears and in-
5 serting “Wright Brothers-Dunbar National Histor-
6 ical Park”;

7 (2) by redesignating subsection (b) of section
8 108 as subsection (e); and

9 (3) by inserting after subsection (a) of section
10 108 the following new subsection:

11 “(b) GRANT ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary may make
12 grants to public and private organizations relating to the
13 preservation, development, use, and interpretation of prop-
14 erties within the boundaries of Wright Brothers-Dunbar
15 National Historical Park, subject to the availability of ap-
16 propriations.”.

17 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law (other
18 than this Act), map, regulation, document, record, or
19 other official paper of the United States to the “Dayton
20 Aviation Heritage National Historical Park” shall be con-
21 sidered to be a reference to the “Wright Brothers-Dunbar
22 National Historical Park”.
