Mr. FRANK of Massachusetts introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to eliminate the time limitation for corrections to wage and self-employment income records.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF TIME LIMITATION FOR COR-**
4 **RECTIONS TO WAGE AND SELF-EMPLOYMENT**
5 **INCOME RECORDS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 205(c)(4) of the Social
7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(c)(4)) is amended to read
8 as follows:

9 “(4) If it is brought to the Commissioner’s attention
10 that any entry of wages or self-employment income in the

1 Commissioner's records is erroneous or that any item of
2 wages or self-employment income has been omitted from
3 such records, the Commissioner may correct such entry
4 or include such omitted item in such records, as the case
5 may be.".

6 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 205(c) of
7 such Act (42 U.S.C. 405(c)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking subparagraph
9 (B) and redesignating subparagraphs (C) and (D)
10 as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respectively; and

11 (2) by striking paragraphs (5) and (6) and re-
12 designating paragraphs (7), (8), and (9) as para-
13 graphs (5), (6), and (7), respectively.

14 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

15 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
16 respect to errors or omissions occurring before, on, or
17 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
