5 (a) PUBLIC SCHOOL PROGRAM.—Section 3(i) of the
6 District of Columbia College Access Act of 1999 (sec. 38–
7 2702(i), D.C. Official Code) is amended by striking “each

1 of the 7 succeeding fiscal years” and inserting “each of
2 the 12 succeeding fiscal years”.

3 (b) PRIVATE SCHOOL PROGRAM.—Section 5(f) of
4 such Act (sec. 38–2704(f), D.C. Official Code) is amended
5 by striking “each of the 7 succeeding fiscal years” and
6 inserting “each of the 12 succeeding fiscal years”.
