## A BILL

To ensure the proper remembrance of Vietnam veterans and the Vietnam War by providing a deadline for the designation of a visitor center for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Vietnam Veterans Me-  
5 morial Visitor Center Deadline Enforcement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE.**

7       Section 6 of Public Law 96–297 (as added by Public  
8 Law 108–126) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
9 lowing:

10       “(e) DEADLINE.—Notwithstanding any other law,  
11 the visitor center authorized by subsection (a) shall be lo-  
12 cated in the open land in the triangular land area between  
13 Henry Bacon Drive, 23rd Street, Constitution Avenue,  
14 and the Lincoln Memorial, and final approval of the visitor  
15 center shall occur no later than 30 days following enact-  
16 ment of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Visitor Center  
17 Deadline Enforcement Act.”.
