A BILL

To revise the limitation on Impact Aid special payments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Impact Aid Update
5 Act of 2006”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON IMPACT AID SPECIAL PAYMENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8002 of the Elementary
8 and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 77002)
9 is amended in subsection (i)(1)—

10 (1) by striking “1997” and inserting “2003”;

11 and

12 (2) by striking “1996” and inserting “2002”.

1 (b) SPECIAL RULES FOR FISCAL 2006.—

2 (1) RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.—The
3 amendments made by this section apply retroactively
4 to all of fiscal year 2006.

5 (2) AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN FISCAL 2005
6 FUNDS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of
7 law, the Secretary of Education shall make available
8 a total of \$1,800,000 from the funds appropriated
9 for fiscal year 2005 under the heading “Vocational
10 and Adult Education” in Public Law 108–447 that
11 are otherwise available, to increase the payment
12 made to the local educational agency of Highland
13 Falls, New York, under subsection (i) of section
14 8002 of the Elementary and Secondary Education
15 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7702) for fiscal year 2006.
