Mr. SHERMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Tarveen Kaur Anand.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RELATIVE STATUS FOR TARVEEN**
4 **KAUR ANAND.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Tarveen Kaur Anand shall be
6 classified as an immediate relative within the meaning of
7 section 201(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Immigration and Nation-
8 ality Act for purposes of approval of a relative visa petition
9 filed under section 204 of such Act by Tarveen Kaur
10 Anand and the filing of an application for an immigrant
11 visa or for adjustment of status.

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Tarveen Kaur
2 Anand enters the United States before the filing deadline
3 specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered to have
4 entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligi-
5 ble, be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245
6 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of
7 the enactment of this Act.

8 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
9 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the pe-
10 tition and the application for issuance of an immigrant
11 visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed
12 with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the
13 enactment of this Act.

14 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
15 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
16 idence to Tarveen Kaur Anand, the Secretary of State
17 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, for the
18 following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
19 available under section 201(c)(1)(A) of the Immigration
20 and Nationality Act.

21 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
22 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
23 parents, brothers, and sisters of Tarveen Kaur Anand
24 shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any

1 right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Na-
2 tionality Act.
