## A BILL

To require persons seeking Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approval for a liquefied natural gas facility to identify employees and agents engaged in activities to persuade communities of the benefits of such approval.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT.**

4       The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall re-  
5       quire an applicant for approval, by the Commission under  
6       the Natural Gas Act, of the siting, construction, expan-  
7       sion, or operation of a liquefied natural gas facility to  
8       identify each of their employees or agents that are en-

1 gaged, directly or indirectly, in activities to persuade com-  
2 munities of the benefits of such approval. The Commission  
3 shall maintain a publicly available database listing all such  
4 employees and agents.
