Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To provide that Federal property reversions on land deeded to the Municipality of Anchorage be conveyed to the Municipality in order to unencumber the Municipality's title.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVERSION CONVEYANCES, ANCHORAGE,**
4 **ALASKA.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCES AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
6 the Interior (the “Secretary”) shall convey, without con-
7 sideration, to the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the
8 “Municipality”), the reversionary interest of the United

1 States in and to parcels of real property, including im-
2 provements thereon, which are owned by the Municipality
3 and located in Anchorage, Alaska, for the purpose of
4 unencumbering the title of the Municipality.

5 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTIES.—The exact par-
6 cels and legal descriptions of the properties for which the
7 title of the Municipality is subject to a Federal rever-
8 sionary interest to be conveyed by the Secretary to the
9 Municipality under subsection (a) shall be determined in
10 a manner satisfactory to the Secretary.

11 (c) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONSIDERATIONS.—
12 The Secretary may require such additional terms and con-
13 ditions with the conveyances as the Secretary considers
14 appropriate to protect the interests of the United States.
