RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 403) to amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit taking minors across State lines in circumvention of laws requiring the involvement of parents in abortion decisions.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (S. 403) to amend
4 title 18, United States Code, to prohibit taking minors
5 across State lines in circumvention of laws requiring the
6 involvement of parents in abortion decisions. The amend-

1 ment in the nature of a substitute printed in the report
2 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution
3 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall
4 be considered as read. The previous question shall be con-
5 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage
6 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
7 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
8 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary;
9 and (2) one motion to commit with or without instruc-
10 tions.
