RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 22) expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that American small businesses are entitled to a Small Business Bill of Rights.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 22)
4 expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that
5 American small businesses are entitled to a Small Busi-
6 ness Bill of Rights. The amendments to the resolution and

1 the preamble recommended by the Committee on Small
2 Business now printed in the resolution are considered as
3 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
4 dered on the resolution and preamble, as amended, to final
5 adoption without intervening motion or demand for divi-
6 sion of the question except: (1) one hour of debate equally
7 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on Small Business; and
9 (2) one motion to recommit, which may not contain in-
10 structions.
