Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 366) to amend the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Technical Education Act of 1998 to strengthen and improve programs under that Act.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 366) to amend the Carl D. Perkins

1 Vocational and Technical Education Act of 1998 to
2 strengthen and improve programs under that Act. The
3 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
4 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
5 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
6 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
7 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
8 Education and the Workforce. After general debate the
9 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
10 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
11 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
12 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
13 ommended by the Committee on Education and the Work-
14 force now printed in the bill. The committee amendment
15 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.
16 Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment
17 to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
18 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the
19 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each
20 such amendment may be offered only in the order printed
21 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
22 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
23 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
24 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
25 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to

1 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
2 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
3 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-
4 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
5 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
6 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
7 separate vote in the House or any amendment adopted
8 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-
9 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-
10 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
11 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
12 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or
13 without instructions.
