Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3057) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3057) making appropriations for

1 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
4 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of
5 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to
6 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
7 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
8 of the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
10 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill
11 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived
12 except as follows: beginning with “or” on page 113, line
13 26, through page 114, line 10. Where points of order are
14 waived against part of a section, points of order against
15 a provision in another part of such section may be made
16 only against such provision and not against the entire sec-
17 tion. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the
18 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord pri-
19 ority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member
20 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the
21 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
22 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed
23 shall be considered as read. When the committee rises and
24 reports the bill back to the House with a recommendation
25 that the bill do pass, the previous question shall be consid-

- 1 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
- 2 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
- 3 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
