RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 612 expressing the commitment of the House of Representatives to achieving victory in Iraq.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res.
4 612) expressing the commitment of the House of Rep-
5 resentatives to achieving victory in Iraq. The resolution
6 shall be considered as read. The previous question shall
7 be considered as ordered on the resolution and preamble

1 to final adoption without intervening motion or demand
2 for division of the question except: (1) one hour of debate
3 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
4 ing minority member of the Committee on International
5 Relations; and (2) one motion to recommit which may not
6 contain instructions.

7 SEC. 2. On the first legislative day of the second ses-
8 sion of the One Hundred Ninth Congress, the House shall
9 not conduct organizational or legislative business.
