Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on
2 the legislative day of Saturday, December 17, 2005, for
3 the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend
4 the rules relating to the following measures:

5 (1) The bill (H.R. 4519) to amend the Public
6 Health Service Act to extend funding for the oper-
7 ation of State high risk health insurance pools.

8 (2) The bill (H.R. 2520) to provide for the col-
9 lection and maintenance of human cord blood stem

1 cells for the treatment of patients and research, and
2 to amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize
3 the C. W. Bill Young Cell Transplantation Program.

4 (3) The bill (H.R. 4568) to improve proficiency
5 testing of clinical laboratories.

6 (4) The bill (H.R. 3402) to authorize appro-
7 priations for the Department of Justice for fiscal
8 years 2006 through 2009, and for other purposes.

9 (5) The bill (H.R. 4579) to amend title I of the
10 Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974,
11 title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act, and
12 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend by one
13 year provisions requiring parity in the application of
14 certain limits to mental health benefits.

15 (6) The bill (H.R. 4525) to temporarily extend
16 the programs under the Higher Education Act of
17 1965, and for other purposes.

18 (7) The conference report to accompany the bill
19 (S. 1281) to reauthorize the human space flight,
20 aeronautics, and science programs of the National
21 Aeronautics and Space Administration, and for
22 other purposes.

23 (8) The conference report to accompany the bill
24 (S. 467) to extend the applicability of the Terrorism
25 Risk Insurance Act of 2002.

1 (9) A joint resolution making further con-
2 tinuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2006, and
3 for other purposes.
