Requesting the President and directing the Secretary of Defense to transmit to the House of Representatives all information in the possession of the President or the Secretary of Defense relating to the collection of intelligence information pertaining to persons inside the United States without obtaining court-ordered warrants authorizing the collection of such information and relating to the policy of the United States with respect to the gathering of counterterrorism intelligence within the United States.

Mr. WEXLER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

RESOLUTION

Requesting the President and directing the Secretary of Defense to transmit to the House of Representatives all information in the possession of the President or the Secretary of Defense relating to the collection of intelligence information pertaining to persons inside the United States without obtaining court-ordered warrants authorizing the collection of such information and relating to the policy of the United States with respect to the gathering of counterterrorism intelligence within the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That—

1 (1) the President is requested to transmit to
2 the House of Representatives, not later than 14 days
3 after the date of the adoption of this resolution, all
4 documents, including telephone and electronic mail
5 records, logs, calendars, minutes, and memos, in the
6 possession of the President relating to—

7 (A) the scope of the activities undertaken
8 by the Department of Defense, the Counter-
9 intelligence Field Activity, or any related agen-
10 cy with regard to Threat and Local Observation
11 Notice reports (TALONs); and

12 (B) the legal authority upon which surveil-
13 lance by the National Security Agency or the
14 Department of Defense of persons inside the
15 United States and the gathering of
16 counterterrorism intelligence within the United
17 States without obtaining court-ordered warrants
18 is based; and

19 (2) the Secretary of Defense is directed to
20 transmit to the House of Representatives, not later
21 than 14 days after the date of the adoption of this
22 resolution, all documents, including telephone and
23 electronic mail records, logs, calendars, minutes,
24 memos, and records of internal discussions, in the
25 possession of the Secretary relating to—

1 (A) the scope of the activities undertaken
2 by the Department of Defense, the Counter-
3 intelligence Field Activity, or any related agen-
4 cy with regard to Threat and Local Observation
5 Notice reports; and

6 (B) the legal authority upon which surveil-
7 lance by the National Security Agency or the
8 Department of Defense of persons inside the
9 United States and the gathering of
10 counterterrorism intelligence within the United
11 States without obtaining court-ordered warrants
12 is based.
