RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 895) supporting intelligence and law enforcement programs to track terrorists and terrorist finances conducted consistent with Federal law and with appropriate Congressional consultation and specifically condemning the disclosure and publication of classified information that impairs the international fight against terrorism and needlessly exposes Americans to the threat of further terror

attacks by revealing a crucial method by which terrorists are traced through their finances.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res.
4 895) supporting intelligence and law enforcement pro-
5 grams to track terrorists and terrorist finances conducted
6 consistent with Federal law and with appropriate Congres-
7 sional consultation and specifically condemning the disclo-
8 sure and publication of classified information that impairs
9 the international fight against terrorism and needlessly ex-
10 poses Americans to the threat of further terror attacks
11 by revealing a crucial method by which terrorists are
12 traced through their finances. The resolution shall be con-
13 sidered as read. The previous question shall be considered
14 as ordered on the resolution and preamble to final adop-
15 tion without intervening motion or demand for division of
16 the question except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided
17 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
18 member of the Committee on Financial Services; and (2)
19 one motion to recommit which may not instructions.
