Whereas the families and friends of the servicemen and women killed in Iraq and Afghanistan have suffered immensely at the loss of their loved ones; and

Whereas the families of the servicemen and women killed in Iraq and Afghanistan deserve to have their privacy respected: Now, therefore, be it
