## RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1       *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule  
2 XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the  
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to  
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-  
5 ported on the legislative day of July 27, 2006, providing  
6 for consideration or disposition of any of the following  
7 measures:

1           (1) A conference report to accompany the bill  
2           (H.R. 2830) to amend the Employee Retirement In-  
3           come Security Act of 1974 and the Internal Revenue  
4           Code of 1986 to reform the pension funding rules,  
5           and for other purposes.

6           (2) A bill to amend the Internal Revenue Code  
7           of 1986 to increase the unified credit against the es-  
8           tate tax to an exclusion equivalent of \$5,000,000, to  
9           repeal the sunset provision for the estate and gen-  
10          eration-skipping taxes, and to extend expiring provi-  
11          sions, and for other purposes.
