A BILL

To waive the passport fees for a relative of a deceased member of the Armed Forces proceeding abroad to visit the grave of such member or to attend a funeral or memorial service for such member.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PASSPORT FEES.**

4 Section 1 of the Act of June 4, 1920 (41 Stat. 750,
5 chapter 223; 22 U.S.C. 214) is amended in the third sen-

1 tence by striking “or from a widow, child, parent, brother,
2 or sister of a deceased member of the Armed Forces pro-
3 ceeding abroad to visit the grave of such member” and
4 inserting “or from a widow, widower, child, parent, grand-
5 parent, brother, or sister of a deceased member of the
6 Armed Forces proceeding abroad to visit the grave of such
7 member or to attend a funeral or memorial service for
8 such member”.
