A BILL

To temporarily suspend the duty on Baytron and Baytron P.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BAYTRON AND BAYTRON P.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.39.15 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain aqueous dispersions) is amended by inserting “,
7 whether or not containing binder resin and organic sol-
8 vent” immediately before “(CAS No.” and by striking
9 “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2009”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
