3 **SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF FAMILY MEMBERS.**

4 Section 105(b)(3) of the Ethics in Government Act
5 of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “or a
7 family member of that individual” after “that indi-
8 vidual”; and

1 (2) in subparagraph (B)(i), by inserting “or a
2 family member of that individual” after “the re-
3 port”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PUBLIC FILING REQUIREMENT.**

5 Section 105(b)(3)(E) of the Ethics in Government
6 Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended by striking
7 “2005” each place it appears and inserting “2010”.
