**A BILL**

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**  
4 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

5 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section  
6 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would

1 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-  
2 mission project numbered 11480, the Commission may, at  
3 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-  
4 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-  
5 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and  
6 the Commission's procedures under that section extend  
7 the time period during which the licensee is required to  
8 commence the construction of the project for 3 consecutive  
9 2-year periods beyond the date that is 4 years after the  
10 date of issuance of the license.
