Mr. LEVIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Marcos Antonio Sanchez-Diaz.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR MARCOS**
4 **ANTONIO SANCHEZ-DIAZ.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act, Marcos Antonio Sanchez-Diaz shall be eligible for
8 issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status
9 to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi-
10 dence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi-
11 grant visa under section 204 of that Act or for adjustment
12 of status to lawful permanent resident.

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Marcos Antonio
2 Sanchez-Diaz enters the United States before the filing
3 deadline specified in subsection (c), Marcos Antonio
4 Sanchez-Diaz shall be considered to have entered and re-
5 mained lawfully and shall be eligible for adjustment of sta-
6 tus under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act as of the date of enactment of this Act.

8 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
9 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
10 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
11 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
12 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

13 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
14 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
15 idence to Marcos Antonio Sanchez-Diaz, the Secretary of
16 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, dur-
17 ing the current or next following fiscal year, the total num-
18 ber of immigrant visas that are made available to natives
19 of the country of birth of Marcos Antonio Sanchez-Diaz
20 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
21 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas
22 that are made available to natives of the country of birth
23 of Marcos Antonio Sanchez-Diaz under section 202(e) of
24 that Act.
