A BILL

To extend the time required for construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Idaho, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARROWROCK HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT.**

4 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
5 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would

1 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
2 mission project numbered 4656, on request of the licensee,
3 the Commission shall—

4 (1) if the license for the project is in effect on
5 the date of enactment of this Act, extend the period
6 for commencing construction of project works for a
7 period of 3 years beginning on the date of enactment
8 of this Act; or

9 (2) if the license for the project ~~expired~~ *has*
10 *been terminated* before the date of enactment of this
11 Act, reinstate and extend the period for commencing
12 construction of project works for an additional 3-
13 year period beginning on the date of enactment of
14 this Act.
