## A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 14, United States Code, to provide for the use of gold in the metal content of the Medal of Honor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GOLD CONTENT FOR MEDAL OF HONOR.**

4 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR GOLD CONTENT.—Sections  
5 3741, 6241, and 8741 of title 10, United States Code,  
6 and section 491 of title 14, United States Code, are each  
7 amended by inserting after “appropriate design,” the fol-  
8 lowing: “the metal content of which is 90 percent gold and  
9 10 percent alloy and”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any Medal of  
3 Honor awarded after the date of the enactment of this  
4 Act.
