7 the “Hiram L. Fong Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Hiram L. Fong Post
- 3 Office Building”.
