A BILL

To redesignate the Mason Neck National Wildlife Refuge in the State of Virginia as the “Elizabeth Hartwell Mason Neck National Wildlife Refuge”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIZABETH HARTWELL MASON NECK NA-**
4 **TIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE.**

5 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The Mason Neck National
6 Wildlife Refuge in the State of Virginia shall be known
7 and designated as the “Elizabeth Hartwell Mason Neck
8 National Wildlife Refuge”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the refuge referred to in subsection (a) shall be
4 deemed to be a reference to the Elizabeth Hartwell Mason
5 Neck National Wildlife Refuge.
