## A BILL

To extend relocation expenses test programs for Federal employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF RELOCATION EXPENSES TEST**  
4 **PROGRAMS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5739 of title 5, United  
6 States Code, is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “for a pe-  
2           riod not to exceed 24 months”; and

3           (2) in subsection (e), by striking “7 years” and  
4           inserting “11 years”.

5           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
6 this section shall take effect as though enacted as part  
7 of the Travel and Transportation Reform Act of 1998  
8 (Public Law 105–264; 112 Stat. 2350).
