## A BILL

To amend Public Law 106–348 to extend the authorization for establishing a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR ESTABLISHING**  
4               **MEMORIAL.**

5       Section 1 of Public Law 106–348 (40 U.S.C. 1003  
6 note) is amended—

7               (1) in subsection (b), by striking “Commemora-  
8       tive Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).” and in-

1       serting “chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code,  
2       except that section 8903(e) of that title shall not  
3       apply, and this Act and the authority provided by  
4       this Act shall expire on October 24, 2015.”; and

5               (2) in subsection (d), by striking “under section  
6       8(b)” and all that follows and inserting “under sec-  
7       tion 8906(b) of title 40, United States Code, or  
8       upon expiration of the authority for the memorial  
9       under subsection (b), there remains a balance of  
10       funds received for the establishment of the memo-  
11       rial, the Disabled Veterans’ LIFE Memorial Foun-  
12       dation shall transmit the amount of the balance to  
13       the Secretary of the Treasury for deposit in the ac-  
14       count provided for in section 8906(b)(1) of that  
15       title.”.
