A BILL

To temporarily increase the borrowing authority of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for carrying out the national flood insurance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Flood Insur-
5 ance Program Enhanced Borrowing Authority Act of
6 2006”.

7 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN BORROWING AUTHORITY.**

8 The first sentence of subsection (a) of section 1309
9 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
10 4016(a)), as amended by the National Flood Insurance

1 Program Further Enhanced Borrowing Authority Act of
2 2005 (Public Law 109–106; 119 Stat. 2288), is amended
3 by striking “\$18,500,000,000” and inserting
4 “\$21,200,000,000”.

5 **SEC. 3. EMERGENCY SPENDING.**

6 Amendments made pursuant to this Act are des-
7 ignated as emergency spending, as provided under section
8 402 of H. Con. Res. 95 (109th Congress).
