**A BILL**

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to include in the boundaries of the Grand Teton National Park land and interests in land of the GT Park Subdivision, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Grand Teton National  
3 Park Extension Act of 2006”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) **PARK.**—The term “Park” means the Grand  
7 Teton National Park.

8 (2) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means  
9 the Secretary of the Interior.

10 (3) **SUBDIVISION.**—The term “Subdivision”  
11 means the GT Park Subdivision, with an area of ap-  
12 proximately 49.67 acres, as generally depicted on the  
13 plat recorded in the Office of the Teton County  
14 Clerk and Recorder on December 16, 1997, num-  
15 bered 918, entitled “Final Plat GT Park Subdivi-  
16 sion”, and dated June 18, 1997, and the map enti-  
17 tled “2006 Proposed Grand Teton Boundary Adjust-  
18 ment”, numbered 136/80,198, and dated March 21,  
19 2006, which shall be on file and available for inspec-  
20 tion in any appropriate office of the National Park  
21 Service.

22 **SEC. 3. ACQUISITION OF LAND.**

23 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary shall accept from  
24 any willing donor the donation of any land or interest in  
25 land of the Subdivision.

1 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—On acquisition of land or an  
2 interest in land under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—

3 (1) include the land or interest in the bound-  
4 aries of the Park; and

5 (2) administer the land or interest as part of  
6 the Park, in accordance with all applicable laws (in-  
7 cluding regulations).

8 (c) RESTRICTION ON TRANSFER.—The Secretary  
9 shall not donate, sell, exchange, or otherwise transfer any  
10 land acquired under this section without express author-  
11 ization from Congress.

12 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

13 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-  
14 retary such sums as are necessary to carry out this Act.

15 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

16 *This Act may be cited as the “Grand Teton National*  
17 *Park Extension Act of 2006”.*

18 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

19 *In this Act:*

20 (1) *PARK.*—*The term “Park” means the Grand*  
21 *Teton National Park.*

22 (2) *SECRETARY.*—*The term “Secretary” means*  
23 *the Secretary of the Interior.*

1           (3) *SUBDIVISION.*—*The term “Subdivision”*  
2           *means the GT Park Subdivision, with an area of ap-*  
3           *proximately 49.67 acres, as generally depicted on—*

4                   (A) *the plat recorded in the Office of the*  
5                   *Teton County Clerk and Recorder on December*  
6                   *16, 1997, numbered 918, entitled “Final Plat GT*  
7                   *Park Subdivision”, and dated June 18, 1997;*  
8                   *and*

9                   (B) *the map entitled “2006 Proposed Grand*  
10                   *Teton Boundary Adjustment”, numbered 136/*  
11                   *80,198, and dated March 21, 2006, which shall*  
12                   *be on file and available for inspection in appro-*  
13                   *priate offices of the National Park Service.*

14 **SEC. 3. ACQUISITION OF LAND.**

15           (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary may accept from*  
16           *any willing donor the donation of any land or interest in*  
17           *land of the Subdivision.*

18           (b) *ADMINISTRATION.*—*On acquisition of land or an*  
19           *interest in land under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—*

20                   (1) *include the land or interest in the boundaries*  
21                   *of the Park; and*

22                   (2) *administer the land or interest as part of the*  
23                   *Park, in accordance with all applicable laws (includ-*  
24                   *ing regulations).*

1       (c) *DEADLINE FOR ACQUISITION.*—*It is the intent of*  
2 *Congress that the acquisition of land or an interest in land*  
3 *under subsection (a) be completed not later than 1 year*  
4 *after the date of enactment of this Act.*

5       (d) *RESTRICTION ON TRANSFER.*—*The Secretary shall*  
6 *not donate, sell, exchange, or otherwise transfer any land*  
7 *acquired under this section without express authorization*  
8 *from Congress.*

9       **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10       *There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-*  
11 *retary such sums as are necessary to carry out this Act.*

Amend the title so as to read: “To modify the boundaries of Grand Teton National Park to include certain land within the GT Park Subdivision, and for other purposes.”.
