## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Bromoxynil Meo.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BROMOXYNIL MEO.**

4        Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.10.57	2,6-Dibromo-4-cyanophenyl octanoate/heptanoate (CAS Nos. 1689-99-2 and 56634-95-8) (provided for in subheading 3808.30.15) ..	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

7        (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
8 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
